**The Kurds are the fourth largest ethnic group in the Middle East. Yet, for hundreds of years they have lived under the governments of Turkey, Iran, Iraq, Syria and Armenia. Today, with over 35 million, they still continually clash with governing regimes. Pray for peace and changed hearts through the salvation of Jesus Christ.**



**High illiteracy rates among the Kurds create obstacles to sharing the Word of God. The Kurds speak four different dialects which further complicates bringing them the gospel. Pray that God would use every means necessary...Christian witness, the Word, dreams and visions...to bring Kurds into His kingdom.**

**Kurds in Turkey have little access to the gospel with fewer than 25 mission workers among this group of over 16 million. Pray that God will call more people to work among the Kurds.**



**Kurdish children have limited access to education. Pray for someone to tell the story of Jesus. They grow up and live their lives without ever hearing the truth of the gospel. Ask God to break this chains that bind them and bring many children to the one who loved the little children ...Jesus.**

**More than 5 million Kurds live in Iran. Primarily located in the northwest region, most Kurds live as marginalized people within the country. Jobs, education, and opportunities are extremely limited. Pray that Christian radio broadcasts and oral Scriptures in Kurdish will reach them.**

**Nearly 2 million Kurds live in Syria. The majority are Sunni Muslims but there is a small population of Christians. Pray for these small pockets of Christians and for their boldness and faithfulness. Pray that strong Christian leaders will emerge from these groups.**

**Over 200,000 Kurds live in Armenia, 250,000 in Kuwait and another one million in Europe. Add to this, thousands in Lebanon, Israel, Canada, and the United States... and the need for the gospel is great. Pray that the Kurds may know that the world has not forgotten them. They need to know that their heavenly Father loves them.**



**Pray that God will raise up Kurdish men to be the spiritual leaders in their homes and churches and that God will provide discipleship training for them.**



**Pray for the key cities in Azerbaijan where Kurds live: Kelbajar and Lachia**

**Pray for the Kurds in Khursani Province in Iran near the border of Turkmenistan. There are no believers among these Kurds.**

**Pray against Satan's strongholds in the nations where the Kurds live.**

**Pray for the key cities in Iraq where Kurds are: Dohuk, Mosul, Arbil, Kurkuk, Sulaimaniya, Halabja, Rerbanduz, and Kefri.**

**Although the Kurds have been shepherds for centuries, they are like sheep without a shepherd. Pray that they will recognize that Jesus is the only way to salvation and that He is the good shepherd that lay down his life for His sheep.**
